Normal anatomy Brain parenchyma. The brain surface consists of gyri (ridges) and sulci (grooves). In brain edema, the sulci will be compressed, as opposed to atrophy (as in Alzheimer's disease); here the sulci will expand as a result of tissue loss.

CT scan can be used for detecting both acute and chronic changes in the lung parenchyma, that is, the internals of the lungs. It is particularly relevant here because normal two-dimensional X-rays do not show such defects.

In the elderly, CT scanning shows signs of infarction in only approximately half of the most of the common form of lacunar stroke (pure motor stroke), but MRI has increased the yield: the probability that CT or MRI will be positive is generally a function of the severity of the deficit [Mohr JP and Sacco RL, 1992].

The basal vein is not truly a deep vein, rather being a superficial vein at the base of the brain. It is considered deep in surgical literature since it is quite deep as far as the surgeon is concerned and, for example, correlates with a higher degree of morbidity when involved in surgical treatment of AVMs.

Generally, the Townes or an even more steep craniocaudal view is a good idea for visualizing the posterior fossa veins. It has the advantages of elongating the basal vein, and projecting the brainstem structures inferior to the torcula / transverse sinuses, and therefore without undue superimposition.
