### The Poetry of A.A.Milne

Alan Alexander "A. A." Milne (18 January 1882 – 31 January 1956), was an English author, best known for his books about the teddy bear Winnie-the-Pooh and for various children's poems. Milne was a noted writer, primarily as a playwright, before the huge success of Pooh overshadowed all his previous work.

A. A. Milne. Milne published prolifically in many genres, including numerous plays—most notably Mr. Pim Passes By (1919)—and a novel, The Red House Mystery (1922). Milne also published poetry for

adults, including *Behind the Lines* (1940) and *The Norman Church* (1948). He wrote three nonfiction books on war and pacifism, *Peace with Honour* (1934),...
