Glossary of Terms. Anterior chamber: The region of the eye between the cornea and the lens that contains aqueous humor. Aqueous humor: The fluid produced in the eye. Bruch's membrane: Located in the retina between the choroid and the retinal pigmented epithelium (RPE) layer; provides support to the retina and functions as the 'basement' membrane of the RPE layer.

The Eye in Cross Section When we look at a cross section of the eye, we can see the interior structures of the eye. The transparent portion at the very front of the eye is called the cornea.

### **Anatomy of the Eye - Retina-Vitreous SURGEONS-CNY**

The lens is a transparent, biconvex structure in the eye that, along with the cornea, helps to refract light to be focused on the retina. The lens, by changing shape, functions to change the focal distance of the eye so that it can focus on objects at various distances, thus allowing a sharp real image of the object of interest to be formed on the retina. . In humans and most mammals and birds, the iris (plural: irides or irises) is a thin, circular structure in the eye, responsible for controlling the diameter and size of the pupil and thus the amount of light reaching the retina.
